The 7th and 12th grade students at Care Village have returned to school since they are the oldest grade in the primary and secondary schools, with an additional grade being added every two weeks to ensure there is not an increase in corona virus infection. The remaining children at Care Village have been "home schooling" in the large hall at Care Village using furniture donated from Saline. The children are asked to wear their school uniforms and masks, and practice social distancing as the staff tries to create an environment of learning for the children.




South Africa remains quite closed to reduce infection rates since hospitals have very limited capacity and ventilators. The three-month lockdown was intended to give hospitals the opportunity to prepare for the anticipated peak of COVID-19 in August or September. Care Village has a sanitation "tunnel" for all people coming into Care Village designed to prevent the spread of Covid. The children continue to be separated by house groups, and continue to get only an hour of outdoor time each day. The children are antsy and anxious. Siblings and friends from different houses still are not permitted to mingle. The house parents and staff are doing their best to offer emotional support, but resources are thin.



Many thanks to all of you who sent recorded video prayers and audio prayers for the children to play before their meals and at bedtime. As the pandemic continues, this is a great way to send your love to the children. It is still not too late to contribute to this wonderfully received initiative by the children and the house parents.
